the program. Each child should bring one piece of fruit the day of the program to put together into a large fruit salad for our feast. Bring you cameras!



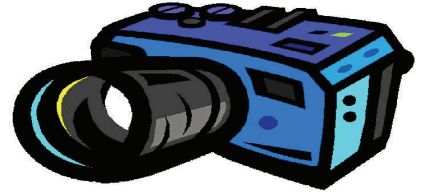
## Show and Tell
